

## **Pre-Workshop Mac Set-Up**

You will need the StatsPlus application and the most recent version of Excel (which you can obtain through UNM's IT website here: <http://it.unm.edu/software/students/index.html>)

When downloading, you have to make sure that your Mac software is updated because this will influence what version of MS Office you will download.

After downloading and setting up MS Office, you can download StatPlus and add it into excel. Additionally, from the Excel 2013 version and up you can add in the Data Analysis ToolPak.

Note: you may need to change your security settings to allow StatPlus to open. To do so, click on the Apple in the upper left corner of your screen, or go to Applications, to open System Preferences. Go to Security and Privacy, and under the General Tab, select Anywhere from the options under the Allow apps downloaded from. You may also need to click on the lock in the lower left corner to enable changes.
